CITY OF SOUTH FULTON POLICE TO BE SWORN INTO SERVICE ON THE OFFICIAL TRANSITION DAY

Interim Chief Sheila Rogers will Administer the Oath of Office

The City of South Fulton is continuing its successful development of coordinated public safety activities on **Monday, March 26, 2018**, by swearing-in members of the inaugural City of South Fulton Police Department. This will mark another public safety milestone with the swearing-in of the city's first ever City of South Fulton Police Department. Interim Chief Sheila Rogers will administer the Oath of Office to more than 85 members of this new law enforcement agency. Mayor William "Bill" Edwards, City Manager Odie Donald II, and the City Council will formally welcome the newest employees to the City of South Fulton, and address the overall transition of public safety services to the city. This swearing-in ceremony is open to the public and the community is encouraged to attend.
